

Jersey Children's Home Abuse Page

DATE: 18 MARCH 2008

Police are currently investigating allegations of sexual and physical abuse of children (both male and female) at the Haut de la Garenne children's home in Jersey.
Some of these allegations date back at least 40 years.

Pictons has a specialist team dedicated to claims on behalf of child or adult survivors of abuse.

The team leader, Tracey Emmott, is one of only 11 Panel Members of the Association for Child Abuse Lawyers ("ACAL").

Although police enquiries are currently focussed on the Haut de la Garenne home, police are urging anyone with information about child abuse in any institution in Jersey to come forward.
